Standard Coordinated Finishes



In that wood is a product of nature with no two pieces being exactly the same, the difference of shading that occur in wood finishes are influenced in part by the graining, minerals and natural variations of the wood. These variations do not in any way affect the durability of the chair, but rather give each piece its own unique character and features to coordinate with other furniture pieces. Our experienced finishers can apply wood stain finishes that coordinate well with the standard finishes on this card and will do the same for any laminate or wood samples you provide with your purchase order. NOTE: For quantities of ten or fewer there is a \$10 per item upcharge. In addition, some special finishes may require an upcharge ... consult with sales service for particulars.

It is always preferable to have an actual piece of the wood finish sample to coordinate to, however, it is common to do so with samples of laminates. When there are variations in a sample finish piece our goal is to coordinate our finish between the variations unless you specify for us to go toward the darker or lighter tones. As a rule, the larger a finish sample piece is, whether wood or laminate, the better the finish interpretation. NOTE: These are printed samples. Due to material and printing limitations, these colors are offered as guidelines only and may vary in production.
